

Frequently Asked Questions

1. How much is it and whats included?

The entry cost per vehicle/ team is \$1500 and entries close on the 30th August 2022. There is a 1hr open pit lane timed practice, followed by a shootout of which every garage is also included. Event entry is via Motorsport Australia event entry member portal.

2. What categories are eligible?

The Event is for 3J Improved Production cars including (but not limited to) BMW E30's, 3E Production cars including (but not limited to) Circuit Excels, RX8 Cup cars, Toyota 86 series cars, 3K Saloon Cars, 2B Porsche 944 Challenge cars, and Invited cars at the Event Organisers discretion. 3. Is there practice available?

Yes there is a one hour practice open pitlane available on the morning of the event. Friday practice is also available as per normal Winton test 'n' tune days, enter via Winton Raceway website.

4. Are spectators allowed?

Yes spectators are welcome free of charge.

5. How do we refuel the cars during the race?

The race incorporates pitlane refuelling pit stops which have a minimum stop time of 5mins for cars that have a fuel carrying capacity of 80ltrs or less. For cars that have a fuel carrying capacity over 80ltrs they have a minimum stop time of 6mins. Refuelling can be completed via 2 methods, first option is an overhead dry break type and the second option is a rotary drum pump with a 60L container. 6. Can I hire or purchase a fuel rig setup?

Yes you can hire or purchase a drum pump type fuel rig setup from Raceworks Promotions but there are only a limited number available, please enquire via email events@raceworkspromotions.com.au .

7. Do we require fire extinguishers and are they available for hire?

Yes you require at least one 9kg ABE powder fire extinguisher or 2x 4.5kg ABE powder fire extinguisher, they are available for hire through Raceworks Promotions to enquire events@raceworkspromotions.com.au

8. What clothing attire does my crew require if near or part of refuelling activities?

As per Motorsport Australia Manual schedule D.

One-piece overalls of flame-resistant materials extending from neck to wrists to ankles. Where such overalls consist of a single layer of material, separate flame-resistant underwear extending from neck to wrists to ankles must also be worn.

A flame-resistant balaclava which covers the entire head and neck save for one or two eye openings, unless a helmet providing a similar level of protection is worn.

Goggles which cover all exposed areas of skin not covered by the balaclava, or a full-face helmet and visor.

Shoes of leather or other flame-resistant materials which completely cover the feet and which fit closely around the ankle to minimise the ingress of spilt fuel. The soles must be resistant to fuel.

Those directly handling fuel shall require socks and gloves which comply with the requirements of the FIA 1986 or 8856-2000 or 8856-2018 standard.

We strongly recommend a minimum 2 layer race suit compliant to FIA 1986 or 8856-2000 or 8856-2018 standard.

9. Pit crew requirements

You will require a minimum of 4 personnel for refuelling pitstops, however drivers can perform pit crew duties if you do not have 4 dedicated crew members available. See supplementary regs for further information. Supplementary regulations link below.

10. What other event services are available during the event?

Traction Tyres will be available at the track from Friday afternoon and all day Saturday to support competitors tyre needs.

Winton's Fuel station will be open all day Saturday supplying BP98 and E85.

Winton's onsite kiosk will be open for breakfast and lunch.

A photographer will be onsite taking happy snaps during the course of the day, photos will be available for purchase directly through the photography company.
